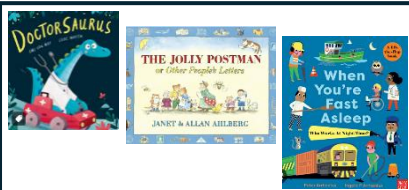


Hoglet's Autumn Term Newsletter 2026

Literacy
